

NEW MINNESOTA BENEFITS FOR 100% P&T DISABLED VETERANS



Exempt from Vehicle Registration Fees - Effective January 1, 2024

01

Exempt from registration fees (including filing fees) for two vehicles of Veterans choosing. This includes passenger vehicles, non-commercial 1-ton pick-up trucks, motorcycles, and RVs. This does NOT include personalized plate fee, annual contributions for special plates, reinstatement fees or impound fees

Exempt from Vehicle Title Fees - Effective January 1, 2024

02

Exempt from title fees (including filing fees) for vehicles purchased on or after the effective date. This does NOT include salvage inspections or fast track fees.

Exempt from Driver's License & ID Card Fees - Effective January 1, 2024

03

Exempt from driver's license and identification card fees for all types of cards (Standard, Real ID, and Enhanced).

Exempt from Paying Motor Vehicle Sales Taxes - Effective June 30, 2024

04

Exempt from paying motor vehicle sales taxes for vehicles purchased on or after that date.

In order to take advantage of any of these Minnesota benefits, Veterans must show proof of their 100% disability. Any of the following documents are acceptable for eligibility verification: Annual VA Benefits Summary Letter, VA Rating Decision, or DoD Issued Military ID Card with 100% rating annotated in the affiliation section.
